## Dubbo and District Football Association Inc. Gala Day Rules - 2023

- 1. All duty teams are under instruction/direction of the Junior Competition Secretary on the day. All decisions are final.
- 2. All Dubbo & DFA Inc clubs are on duty for the duration of the carnival.
- 3. All Dubbo & DFA registered teams to participate in the carnival.
- 4. Gala Day carnival 2023 to consist of all age groups (u5 to u11) competing in three or more games over the course of the day.
- 5. The first game to commence at 9.00am
- 6. All games commence and conclude with the sound of a hooter. Delays in commencement of play will result in shorter playing time.
- 7. All games are 20 minutes in duration. (2x10 minute halves with no half time break)
- 8. The Sound of a single long blast means half time. Teams to change ends immediately and restart the game.
- 9. Sounding of a double blast indicates full time- competing teams to vacate the field as soon as possible.
- 10. There will be a five-minute break between games.
- 11. Teams listed as the "Home Team" are to commence the game by kicking off, the "Away Team" team to commence the second half.
- 12. No record is kept of the result of the game.
- 13. Each team coach collects their team bag with medals at the conclusion of each team's final game for the day and presents them to their players.
- 14. Duty club is responsible for fulfilling the requirements of the checklist and ensuring all litter has been cleaned up at the conclusion of the day.
